- GO Transit: Travel by GO to Niagara Falls and travel stress-free, conveniently & economically.
 - Save with GO / WEGO combo tickets starting at \$18/adult
 - Kids 12 and under ride free on all GO Trains; children 3-12 pay \$8 for the Niagara transportation portion
 - \$62.50/group including tax (up to 5 people, max 2 adults 18+ per group).
 - Tickets include a round-trip GO Train ride from Union Station to Niagara Falls and Niagara WEGO shuttle bus service throughout the Falls.
