Niagara Falls Moves to Step One of Ontario's Roadmap to Reopen Beginning June 11, 2021

Niagara Falls Tourism Shares What's Open and Other Resources to Help Visitors Plan During Provincewide Reopening

Following Ontario's announcement that the province will safely enter Step One of its Roadmap to Reopen on Friday, June 11, 2021, Niagara Falls Tourism is sharing online resources to help visitors with planning during the province's gradual easing of restrictions.

During Step One, Niagara Falls offers world-class accommodation, attractions, outdoor parks and landscaped gardens, a designated nature reserve, scenic hiking trails, golf, cycling trails, outdoor patio dining, birdwatching hotspots and nearby wine region and farmland to explore beyond the famous waterfalls. Looking ahead, the destination is planning for the reopening of entertainment venues, casinos, spas and indoor attractions.

As of June 11th, guests in Niagara Falls can enjoy:

- Patio dining, up to 4 people per table (members of the same household with exceptions)

- Outdoor parks, nature reserve and world-renowned garden spaces: Queen Victoria Park, Oakes Garden Theatre, Niagara Parks Botanical Gardens, Dufferin Islands, Queenston Heights Park, Niagara Glen (hikers are urged to obey safety measures, including following trail markers and staying a safe distance from water as the powerful Niagara River has class 6 rapids.)
